Management

The North Dakota Water Users Association is governed by a board of directors consisting of three elected directors each from nine districts, plus three ex officio members. Ex officio members include the director of the North Dakota Department of Water Resources, the manager of the Garrison Diversion Conservancy District, and a tribal representative. An executive committee is made up of one elected director from each of the nine districts. The Executive Vice-President serves the board.

Governmental Affairs

Membership in the North Dakota Water Users helps support critical policy efforts. The Water Users advocates for effective water policy at the state and federal level. In addition to lobbying during the state legislative session, the Water Users is also actively engaged with various state agencies including the State Water Commission and Department of Water Resources. Year round, members of the Water Users receive regular updates on relevant state and federal policy issues. During legislative session, all Water Users members receive weekly legislative updates.

Communication and Events

Information sources for members include:

- All members receive one subscription to North Dakota Water magazine, and water resource district members, public members, and sustaining members receive up to 12 subscriptions.
- The North Dakota Water Users hosts the annual Water Convention in December. The Water Convention is a two-day conference featuring national and statewide experts on water management, development and policy.
- The North Dakota Water Users Association is a member of the National Water Resources Association (NWRA). NWRA advocates in DC for strong federal water policy.
